This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.4 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of respondent No.5 and to take action on complaint dated 03.12.2019 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made complaint on 03.12.2019 to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4 – Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into and decide complaint dated 03.12.2019 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
