The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.398 dated 25.12.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 452 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Asauda, Bahadurgarh District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of over a day in lodging the FIR and the petitioner has been falsely implicated because of an old dispute. He also contends that offence under Section 326 IPC has been invoked with regard to an injury on the hand of the complainant.

Learned State counsel has furnished a copy of the MLR of the complainant which indicates that he has received two injuries including one on his head and he was not in a position to make a statement, therefore, the delay took place in lodging the FIR.

Heard.

It is alleged that the petitioner, who was armed with a stick, had given several blows to the complainant including an injury on his head. The

relevant extract of the MLR of the complainant is reproduced hereunder:-

Sr. No.	Injuries	Marked	Injury Number
1.	Multiple 5 to 6 cut wounds are present on the parietal area of head and both upper limb forearm. The wounds are linear and oblique with clean margin and spindle shape. The ends of the wound are lapering. Active bleeding from the wound is present on left forearm. Wounds are 5 lo 10 cm long. Depth of wounds could not be ascertained due to bleeding. There is no bridging of the underlying tissue. Other details of wounds may be added. Duration is within 6 hours. Advised Surgery and ortho opinion sharp	No	1
2.	2 to 3 Contused Lacerated Wounds are present on right forearm. The wound are with variable sizes and irregular margins and Irregular shape. Small amount of blood is present with bridging of the underlying tissue. Duration is within 6 hours. Advised Orthopaedician opinion. blunt.	No	2

In view of the serious allegations and the petitioner having caused serious injury on the head of the complainant, I do not deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
