Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.206 dated 25.09.2020 under Sections 307, 379-B, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the co-accused had given a 'kirpan' blow to the complainant and had snatched Rs.7,000/- from him. He further contends that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner while three of the co-accused have been attributed specific injuries. He, however, contends that the parties are known to each other and the incident is outcome of a misunderstanding which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised. Copy of the compromise is at Annexure P-2. He also contends that the injured has fully recovered from the injuries.

This Court, by the order dated 26.08.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Bhagwan Chand, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but no recovery has been effected.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 26.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
