The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.83 dated 21.06.2014 under Sections 457 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 03.03.2020, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of two weeks and on his doing so, he will be released on interim bail. Counsel submits that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and was admitted to ad-interim bail.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, order dated 03.03.2020 is made absolute.

Petition stands accordingly disposed of.
