This petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure is filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 311 dated 09.08.2017 under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula, District Panchkula.

The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in complaint No. NACT 425 of 2015 titled as Badri Parshad v. Rajesh Sharma for commission of offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act regarding dishonour of the Cheque.

Vide order dated 25.03.2021, notice of motion was issued and the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court. Further directions were to admit him on interim bail, subject to furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and submitted his bail bonds.

Learned State counsel is not disputing the statement made by learned

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of. The interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute.

It is clarified that the trial Court would be at liberty to impose further conditions if required to ensure presence of the petitioner.
