In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that his life and liberty is under threat at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8, who are working in police. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the wife of the petitioner died because of the actions of the respondents No.5 to 8 and as the petitioner has been pursuing the said case to seek justice by filing a complaint, he is being pressurised by respondents No.5 to 8 not to approach any authority so as to press the said complaint.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had already approached respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa raising the said grievance but, the copy of the said representation was not retained by him. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will submit another representation to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa within a period of ten days and prays that a direction be issued to the respondent

No.3 to decide the said representation in accordance with law in a time bound manner by passing appropriate speaking order .

Learned State counsel submits that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioner before the respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel hereinabove, he does not press the present petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.
