ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.128 dated 23.09.2020, under Sections 379-B and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged that gold chain had been snatched from the sister-in-law of the complainant. The petitioners are not named in the FIR and have been involved merely on misunderstanding. The complainant has executed an affidavit dated 08.10.2020 wherein it is stated that she does not want to pursue the case. Copy of the affidavit is annexed as Annexure P-2. Petitioner No.1 is 50 year of age while petitioner No.2 is 60 year of age. They are in custody for over 09 months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Balkaran Singh states that the challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined. She also contends that the petitioners are involved in several other cases.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioners, who are ladies, are in custody for 09 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
