Further, it is his case, that judgments annexed as Annexure P-9 (colly) cover the case of the petitioner and thus, a direction may be issued to the competent authority to decide the aforementioned legal notice in accordance with law on the subject.

Learned State counsel has no objection in case such a direction is issued.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending legal notice dated 21.12.2019 (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
