The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ of Habeas Corpus to release the alleged detainee–Renu from the alleged illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 7.

Through order dated 07.09.2021 the State was directed to produce the alleged detainee–Renu before this Court through video conferencing. Pursuant to the said direction the alleged detainee appeared through video conferencing and clearly stated that she being a major was living as per her own will with respondents No.4 to 7.

In the light of the above statement, no merit is found in the present petition.
