Case taken up through video conferencing.

On 23.03.2021, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“Case taken up through Video Conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case for the reason that the complainant company wants to pressurise him; no recoveries were made by the petitioner as the same were entrusted to four recovery officers appointed by the company; a false case has been registered against the petitioner because the petitioner has left the service of the complainant company as he was not being paid his salary; no embezzlement has been done by the petitioner; interim anticipatory bail was granted by the Trial Court but due to certain miscommunication between the petitioner and his counsel appearing for him before the Trial Court he could not join investigation and that the petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation as and when called by the investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

Mr.S.S.Deol, D.A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 16.07.2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.32, dated 23.02.2021, registered under Section 409 IPC at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer."

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sukhraj Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but allegations are serious and the petitioner is accused of embezzling a sum of ₹1,45,735/-.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 23.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
