Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of bail in case FIR No.0015 dated 22.02.2021 under Section 15 of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 29 of NDPS Act was added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

In para 10 of the petition, a categorical assertion has been made by the petitioner that except for the present case, no other case has been registered against him nor is he in custody in any other case. This assertion has been made despite the fact that it had been noticed by the Special Court, Moga in its order dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) that four other criminal cases have been lodged against the petitioner. In response to the notice issued in the petition, the State has filed a short affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Moga, wherein the details of the said cases have been given.

The petitioner has approached this Court with tainted hands. He has tried to mislead the Court and has concealed his criminal antecedents. Discretionary relief of anticipatory bail is not meant for such a person.

Petition is ordered to be dismissed.
