The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 12 dated 09.01.2021, under Sections 147, 148, 323, 341, 379B, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is the outcome of an altercation among the co-villagers in which injuries were received by both the sides. The petitioner himself had received injury on his head. He has referred to the copy of the MLR of the petitioner from Civil Hospital, Palwal at Annexure P1. He also contends that the commission of offence punishable under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, is attributed to co-accused who was allegedly carrying a pistol, but no shot was fired.

This Court, by order dated 23.03.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Mahender Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but rod and other articles are to be recovered from him.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 23.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.

Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of.
