The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not an accused in any case, but as there is FIR No.63 dated 27.02.2021 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 307, 506, 427 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Dhauj, District Faridabad, against the accused including Sumit Kapasia, who is brother-in-law of the present petitioner, house of the petitioner is being raided and he is being harassed and threatened by the police.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Bhupender Singh, D.A.G., Haryana, has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. On instructions from SI Ram Babu, he submits that there is no case against the petitioner and he is not being harassed, as alleged by him.

Heard.

Without making any observations in the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-the Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, District Faridabad, to take note of the contents on the representation(Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and to act in accordance with law.
