Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioners for quashing of order dated 07.09.2018 (Annexure P/3) rendered by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, in terms of which, petitioners have been declared proclaimed persons in case FIR No.146 dated 27.03.2017 under Sections 120-B, 419, 420, 465, 467 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that earlier the petitioners had filed petition (CRM-M-13017-2019) seeking the same relief and this Court, vide order dated 20.03.2019 (Annexure P/4) disposed of the said petition with direction to the petitioners to appear before the Trial Court within 7 days from the date of receipt of certified

copy of that order, failing which the said petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed. He further urges that though petitioners could not surrender before the Court concerned, but as they are now ready to surrender before the Court concerned, similar order, as detailed above, may be passed in the instant petition as well.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioners to surrender before the Court concerned within ten days positively from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed.
