CWP-6739-2021

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant all retiral benefits to the petitioner for the services rendered from 16.09.1986 to 31.03.2001 at the Barnala Multi Purpose CASS

Ltd Barnala, District Barnala and from 31.03.2001 onwards at the Gamiwala CASS Ltd. District Mansa, which was ultimately merged into the Gandu Kalan Multi Purpose CASS Ltd., Gandu Kalan, District Mansa (Principal Society) till his retirement on 31.12.2018, with 18% interest (per annum) on the delayed payments till the actual date of payment and also to allow the petitioner to withdraw his deposit of RS.1419858.73/- along with applicable interest, which is the deposit with (liability of) respondent No.5/Society, against the salary of the petitioner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Copy supplied.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notices dated 19.03.2020 and 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-4 and P-6, respectively) as representations moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without

any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
