Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.27 dated 28.01.2021, under Sections 323, 506 and 34 IPC, Section 10 of the POCSO Act, 2012, registered at Women Police Station, NIT Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner along with the co-accused had given beatings to the complainant and her family members with 'dandas'. He, however, contends that only simple injuries were caused to the complainant. The petitioner is 52 year old lady and is not involved in any other case. The parties are closely related to each other.

This Court, by the order dated 23.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Suman Lata, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 23.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
