This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents and to take action on representations dated 02.03.2021 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 02.03.2021 to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala and Station House Officer, P.S. Subanpur, District Kapurthala, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala, to look into and decide representation dated 02.03.2021 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
