The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this writ petition, filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the merit list dated 24.02.2021 prepared by respondent No.3-The Lubana Teku Multipurpose Co-operative Society. The petitioner contends that in view of Rule 46 of the Punjab Co-operative Societies Rules, 1963, respondent No.4 is not eligible to be appointed.

It is not disputed that the petitioner before filing the writ petition has submitted a representation to the Registrar, Co-operative Societies, (Anexure P-9).

Notice of motion.

On the request of this Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice.

After having heard learned counsel for the parties at some length, this Court is of the considered view that without going into the

merits of the case, it would be appropriate at this stage to dispose of the writ petition by directing the respondent No.2-Registrar, Co-operative Societies, to decide the representation dated 01.03.2021, copy whereof has been annexed as Annexure P-9, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order after granting an opportunity of hearing to all the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
