The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.634 dated 21.12.2012 under Sections 148, 149, 302, 120-B of IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

The pleaded ground on which interim bail is being sought is that the doctor has advised bye-pass surgery to the mother of the petitioner, for which, not only huge money is required, rather she is needed 24 hours care. The petitioner, being son, is the only person to attend the ailing mother. The petitioner is involved in number of other cases. The detail of such cases, reflected in para 16 of the petition, reads as under:-

“1. FIR no.333/08 under section 302, 120B, 34 IPC & 25/54/59 A. Act Police Station Bahadurgarh.

2. *FIR no.300/10 under section 307 IPC Police Station Samuyapur Delhi.*
3. *FIR no.87/16 under section 186, 332, 353, 307, 34 IPC & A. Act Police Station Crime Branch Delhi.*
4. *FIR no.326 dated 03.08.2011 under section 148, 149, 302, 120B, 216, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC & 25/54/59 A. Act Police Station Bahadurgarh.*
5. *FIR no.634 dated 21.12.2012 under section 148, 149, 302, 120B IPC Police Station Bahadurgarh.*
6. *FIR no.638 dated 25.12.2012 under section 387, 506 IPC Police Station Bahadurgarh.*
7. *FIR no.130 dated 26.04.2019 under section 307, 387, 379B, 392, 120B IPC & 25/54/59 A. Act Police Station Asaudha.”*

Noticing the aforesaid details, this Court does not find any good reason to release the petitioner on interim bail.

Dismissed.
