By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.13, dated 03.03.2018, registered at the Womens' Police Station, Sector-17, Chandigarh, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (copy Annexure P-4), arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no.2 .

Pursuant to the previous orders passed by this court, the report of the learned JMIC, Chandigarh, dated 08.03.2021, has been received, stating therein that the complainant, i.e respondent no.2 (Neha Chauhan), appeared before that court and stated that she has settled the matter with the accused and does not wish to pursue the FIR in question.

She has also stated before that court that pursuant a petition filed under the provisions of Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, by her and petitioner no.1, a decree of divorce has also been granted to them.

The compromise, as per the assessment of that court, has been arrived at voluntarily and without any coercion and undue influence.

In view of the above, with learned counsel for respondent no.2 not denying that the matter has been completely settled between the parties and the divorce granted, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.13, dated 03.03.2018, registered at the Womens' Police Station, Sector-17, Chandigarh, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
