This is a writ petition that has been filed seeking extension of parole of the petitioner, who is to surrender on 25.03.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner herein is already on parole for house repair, however, on account of the coming harvesting season, his parole be extended for a further period of six weeks.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Deepshikha Chauhan, AAG Haryana, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and objects to the extension of parole already allowed to the petitioner. It is contended that the petitioner herein is to apply to the proper authorities for them to consider his request. It is submitted that she has no instructions

regarding any representation having been filed by the petitioner with regard to the extension of parole. It is also contended that in fact, parole has already been allowed to the petitioner on the ground of house repair and now he wants to change the purpose of parole and seeks extension for agricultural activities.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to the respondent-State to treat the instant petition as a representation of the petitioner for deciding the case of the petitioner for the purpose of agricultural parole and the same be considered and decided within a period of one week in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
