AJAY TEWARI, J (ORAL)

This petition has been filed challenging the action of the State in declining the prayer for parole by the impugned order on the ground that there are 11 cases registered against the petitioner and he is habitual for indulging in quarrels.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that as a matter of fact, apart from the present case in which the petitioner is presently undergoing imprisonment, all the other cases are minor cases and in many of them, he has been acquitted and in some cases, already served his sentence.

Learned Additional Advocate General is not in a position to deny this fact. Moreover in one of those cases, learned counsel for the petitioner points out that the petitioner is already on bail.

In the circumstances, the impugned order dated 24.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) cannot be sustained. However, the prayer for grant of six weeks' parole is excessive, we deem it appropriate to direct the respondent to release the petitioner on parole for three weeks.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
