The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

CWP No. 2956 of 2021 filed by the petitioner was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 25.12.2020 in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one month.

Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 10.02.2021 passed in CWP No. 2956 of 2021, a speaking order dated 28.04.2021 has been passed. He further states that the retiral benefits of the petitioner have been paid. However, the case for fixing of the pension of the petitioner has been stand to the office of the Accountant General. The needful in this regard is likely to be done within next six weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the legal notice he had also claimed interest on the payment. However, the speaking order passed by the respondent has not dealt with that issue.

Mr. Sharda assures that a separate speaking order would be passed dealing with the claim of the petitioner as pointed out.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered as infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
