The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0029 dated 22.02.2021, under Sections 452, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Sections 307 and 365 IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station City-I Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner is named in the FIR and was armed with a 'danda', but no overt act is attributed to him. He also contends that the petitioner is 22 years of age and not involved in any other case.

This Court, by order dated 24.03.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kahna Ram, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 24.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
