Vide this common order, the above-mentioned petitions arising
out of the same FIR, shall stand disposed of.

Instant petitions have been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for
grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.58/2014 dated
26.06.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 354, 506 and 34 of the IPC

registered at Police Station Mansa Devi Complex, Panchkula, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 07th March 2019, 15th October 2019 and 08th April, 2019 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Rajni Rani submits that though the petitioners have joined investigation, however, recovery of few gold and silver articles have not yet been effected.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that in the aforementioned circumstances, the petitioner be not extended the concession of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has however strongly refuted the instructions received by the learned State counsel by urging that whatever dowry articles, including gold and silver, were in his possession, stand duly returned.

Instant petitions are allowed and interim orders dated 07th March 2019, 15th October 2019 and 08th April, 2019 are made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
