The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.133 dated 22.06.2020 under Sections 307, 452, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Badli, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the case of the prosecution, a solitary pistol shot which hit the stomach of the injured- Aman is attributed to co-accused Mohit. No injury is attributed to the petitioner and the injured has fully recovered from the injury. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over a year since his arrest on 23.06.2020.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Krishan Kumar, states that although challan has been filed but none of the 25 prosecution witnesses have been examined. He also contends that the petitioner is alleged to have fired a shot but it did not hit anyone.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is not attributed any injury, he is in custody for over a year, the Covid-19 pandemic

and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
