The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in cross version bearing GD No. 20 dated 30.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 307, 452, 379, 506, 336, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural registered in FIR No.22 dated 28.01.2021 (Annexure P-2) at the same Police Station under Sections 302, 307, 452, 323, 429, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

The operative part of the order dated 24.03.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is a case of version and cross-version inasmuch as both the parties have received injuries at the hands of each other. He further contends that in fact it was the other party who aggressed into their house and caused

them injuries leading to the death of their servant-Jagtar Singh. He further contends that even a perusal of the FIR in question reveals that no injury has been attributed to the petitioners except their presence stands reflected at the time of occurrence.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 24.03.2021, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 24.03.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
