Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to complete the investigation in FIR No.349 dated 22.10.2020 lodged by her under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was duped by the accused in selling her old furniture and a sum of ₹41,000/- had been fraudulently withdrawn from her bank account. He further contends that the FIR has been registered but the police has not filed the challan.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He upon instructions from ASI Satnam Singh states that 03 accused have been identified and efforts are on to arrest them. They are residing outside the State of Punjab and, therefore, some more time would be required in that regard.

In view of the statement of the learned State counsel, grievance of the petitioner appears to be substantially redressed at this stage.

Consequently, the petition stands disposed of at this stage.
