The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.95 dated 05.03.2021 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Sirsa City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Notice of motion was issued on 02.07.2021 and the interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner. The petitioner was nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Devender Kumar who had allegedly purchased the contraband from the petitioner.

Vide order dated 02.09.2021, one more opportunity was granted to the petitioner by extending the time for joining investigation owing to demise of his mother on 06.07.2021.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amit Kumar submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, but he has antecedent behaviour of criminal activities being involved in number of cases.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is on bail in other cases.

In the very nature of order dated 02.07.2021, I deem it appropriate to confirm the order dated 02.07.2021. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
