The petitioners seek grant of the relief of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing the FIR No.31 dated 17.02.2021, registered under Sections 323, 346, 365, 448, 406, 34, 120-B IPC at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to order dated 25.03.2021, the petitioners have joined investigation.

The aforesaid fact is admitted by the learned State counsel and she states that the petitioners are no longer required for further interrogation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has objected to the bail on the ground that a specially abled person was kidnapped with

appearing in the connected matter i.e. CRM-M-18464-2021 has also opposed the bail on the ground that after the consideration and grant of the bail, petitioners gave beatings to the complainant party. Mr. Navkiran Singh has also argued that he has instructions to submit that signatures of the specially abled person were obtained by the accused by way of fraud.

This bail is subject to the condition that, in case, if the accused administer any kind of threat or beatings to the complainant, then on this ground bail granted to them shall be liable to be cancelled. It shall officially be open for the complainant to file recalling application before this court annexing such future incidents of threat criminal intermediation.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid conditions and interim order dated 25.03.2021 is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
