Affidavit dated 06.08.2021 executed by Seema Sharma, District Food & Supplies Controller, Mewat (Nuh) is on record. According to the said affidavit, a surprise inspection was conducted on 30.10.2021 as a complaint had been received against the petitioner that he is not supplying the rations in accordance with entitlement. During the surprise check, the stock was also inspected and it was found that 20 liters of mustard oil was in excess. Consequently, order of cancellation has been passed after issuance of show-cause-notice and grant of opportunity of hearing. The petitioner was unable to explain the existence of surplus stock.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that surplus stock is admitted, but the same was on account of the fact that certain consumers had not collected their quota of mustard oil. The abovesaid explanation cannot be accepted because if that had that been the case, the sale record would reflect this fact.

In view of above, there is no merit in this writ petition. The same is accordingly dismissed.
