The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of appropriate direction to the official respondents No2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondent Nos. 5 to 8, as they have performed marriage against the wishes of private respondents.

During the course of hearing it is not disputed that the representation was submitted by the petitioners on 22.03.2021 and on the same day the present petition has been filed to seek protection on the ground that they are facing threats from private respondent No. 5 and 8 who are opposing the marriage of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly stated that the

father of the petitioner No.1 has already given a complaint to the police whereupon a case has been registered, however, the particulars of the FIR are not known to the petitioners.

Considering, the above background and the fact that admittedly the private respondents have adopted a remedy in law, therefore, and it cannot be construed as a threat to them.

Resultantly, no ground is made out for invoking the extraordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
