The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 10, who are against the marriage of the petitioners.

On 25.3.2021, learned State counsel sought time to verify the existence of alleged threat.

Status report by way of affidavit of Davinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Shahkot, Jalandhar, has been filed by learned State counsel wherein as per the stand of the official respondents, respective statements of the petitioners were recorded on 19.4.2021 (Annexure R-1/T) who stated that they do not apprehend any danger and do not need any security. Statements of respondents No.4, 5 and 6 (family members of petitioner No.1) have also been recorded as Annexure R-2/T, wherein they have stated that they have no objection to the marriage

of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute this fact and submits that in view of the statements of petitioners, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
