The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.130 dated 01.09.2018, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that 1770 tablets containing tramadol were allegedly recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is 25 years of age and is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act. He is in custody for over 01 year and 05 months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions states that charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 05 months, he is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
