The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 262 dated
19.10.2020 under Sections 186, 332, 353, 506, 34 IPC, 1860 registered at
Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

On 31.03.2021, when the matter came up for hearing before a
Coordinate Bench of this Court, the following order was passed:

*“This is a petition that has been filed for grant
of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.262 dated
19.10.2020 under Sections 186, 332, 353, 506, 34 IPC
registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.*

*Counsel for the petitioner would contend that
reading of contents of the FIR would reflect that in fact no
offence is made out against the petitioner herein. The only
allegation made against the petitioner is that he along with
others stood in front of the bus and obstructed it from going*

ahead. No recovery is to be made from the petitioner and he is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deepshikha Chauhan, AAG, Haryana who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice for the respondent-State.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused the paper book.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation within a period of one week and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List for further consideration on 02.09.2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of the said order, he has joined the investigation and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from MHC Birbal Dass, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 08.04.2021 and he is not required any further.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, more so the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not

involved in any other case, the interim order dated 31.03.2021 is ordered to be made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.

Nothing stated above shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
