The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.19 dated 25.01.2021 under Section 174-A IPC, registered at Police Station City Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present case has been filed against the petitioner on a complaint made by the complainant under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881(for short "the N.I. Act") and the matter has otherwise been compromised between the parties. He refers to the affidavit dated 20.03.2021(Annexure P-12), in support of his contention that the matter has been compromised between the parties. He further submits that vide order dated 14.03.2014,

the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed person. However, the said

complaint filed by the complainant under Section 138 of the N.I. Act was withdrawn on 04.03.2021.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Bhupender Singh, D.A.G., Haryana, has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Heard.

Since the matter has otherwise been compromised between the parties and the complaint filed by the complainant under Section 138 of the N.I. Act has been withdrawn on 04.03.2021, the present petition is disposed of, at this stage with a direction that, in case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial court within a period of 10 days from today, he shall be admitted on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction. However, that would be subject to payment of ₹10,000/- as costs to be deposited by the petitioner with the Bar Association of this Court.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
