Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to give suitable post to the petitioner on compassionate ground on account of the fact that her father had died in harness.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case her Legal Notice dated 26.08.2020 (P-4) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shireesh Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on

behalf of the respondents and innocuous prayer of the petitioner is not opposed by him.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 26.08.2020 (P-4) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 03 (three) months from today.
