The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.56 dated 12.01.2018 registered under Section 135 of the Electricity Act, 2003 at Police Station Anti Power Theft, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 16.03.2020 the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and vide order dated 22.07.2020 with consent of the parties matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court.

During mediation the parties have compromised. Report of Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court has been filed in the connected case bearing No.CRM-M-15231-2020.

Vide order of even date i.e. 19.01.2021 passed in CRM-M-1354-2021 titled as 'Amit Kumar Vs. State of Punjab and another' the above-said FIR has been quashed.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has made statement that in view of quashing of the above-said FIR, the present petition for grant of anticipatory bail has become infructuous.

The petition is accordingly disposed of as having become infructuous.
