After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court and to move a petition for regular bail and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the same, expeditiously.

2. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of a petition for regular bail being filed, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same by taking into account all aspects of the matter, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
