The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, he remains unrepresented.

This is an application filed by the wife of the respondent with a prayer to transfer the proceedings of case bearing No.HMA/15/2021, titled as “Gurpal Singh Vs. Veerpal Kaur”, presently pending before the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Muktsar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.

The petitioner claims that she is staying with 1 ½ years old son and her parents at Barnala. She further claims that the respondent is already defending proceedings in a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C., at Barnala and the distance between Muktsar Sahib and Barnala is stated to be 110 kms.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the application is allowed.

The petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing case No.HMA/15/2021, titled as 'Gurpal Singh Vs. Veerpal Kaur' pending in the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Muktsar Sahib, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 21.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
