The petitioners herein have sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of FIR No.82 dated 01.03.2021 registered at Police Station Faridabad Central, District Faridabad, under Sections 147, 149, 385, 452 and 506 of IPC.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Satyawar, Police Station Faridabad Central, District Faridabad, apprises this Court that both the petitioners had joined in the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 25.03.2021 passed by this Court in the present petition and their custodial interrogation is not required.
