The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.227 dated 04.07.2018 registered under Sections 302, 323, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Madlauda, District Panipat.

By virtue of order dated 06.03.2020, the petitioners have joined the proceedings before the trial Court and were released on interim bail. A copy of order dated 09.03.2020 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat (Duty) has been placed on record in this regard.

This fact is not refuted by the learned State counsel. Learned State counsel further submitted that now the petitioners are not required for any further investigation. Admittedly, during investigation, the petitioners were found to be innocent by the police and they were later on summoned by the trial Court only under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Now, they are not required by the police for any further investigation as has been stated by the learned

State counsel.

In view of the above, order dated 06.03.2020 is made absolute and this petition is allowed. However, it is made clear that the petitioners shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.
