By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.11 dated 12.01.2018, registered at Police Station City South, Moga, District Moga, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 447, 120-B and 511 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners and respondent No.2. A copy of the compromise deed has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

Pursuant to the order of this court dated 26.03.2021, the report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, dated 07.05.2021, has been received, stating to the effect that statements of the parties, i.e. petitioners and respondent No.2 (represented by its Secretary, Dinesh Gupta), were recorded before that court, to the effect that the matter has been

compromised between the parties. It has been further stated that there are only 4 persons involved as accused in the FIR and that the complainant, Dinesh Kumar Gupta (on behalf of the Committee as has been impleaded as respondent No.2), is the only person aggrieved of the matter.

As per the assessment of that Court, the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and voluntary.

Though counsel for respondent No.2 is not present today, however, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed, seen with the report of the learned CJM, Moga, which is about 7 months old today and obviously with respondent No.2 seemingly not having retracted from his statement made before that court, without making any comment on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and FIR No.11, dated 12.01.2018, registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 447, 120-B and 511 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
