The present petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent to take action on the representation dated 30.01.2021 (Annexure P-1) given to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn-Taran regarding protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

As per the allegations in the petition, the husband of the petitioner was a Sarpanch of the village and respondent No.8 had borrowed a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- from the husband of the petitioner with a promise to return the same within a period of one year, however, the said amount has not been returned. On that pretext, a complaint (Annexure P-1) has been given to the police authorities by the petitioner, on which respondent No.8 is extending threat.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab, who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that even respondent No.8 has also given a complaint against the petitioner.

Be whatsoever, it is a clear case that husband of the petitioner has extended a loan to respondent No.8, for which the petitioner has a remedy for filing a suit of recovery, as it is not the job of the police to recover the amount on behalf of the petitioner, if the said loan is not repaid.

Accordingly, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
