The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,  
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.19 dated  
19.02.2020 under Section 498-A of the IPC registered at Police Station  
Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

It is the case of the petitioner that the FIR in question was got  
registered on account of matrimonial dispute between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter  
stands amicably settled between the parties and in compliance of order  
dated 01<sup>st</sup> July 2021 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Darshan Kumar does not dispute the said fact and submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 01<sup>st</sup> July 2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
