Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.104 dated 19.10.2019 under Sections 420,120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 registered at P.S Division D, Amritsar.

Vide order dated 16.03.2020, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Amarjit Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 16.03.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
