Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to decide the representation given by the petitioner against respondent Nos. 5 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has a civil suit for permanent injunction restraining respondent Nos. 7 and 8 from interfering in the working of the petitioner as *Pujari* in the village temple or by forcibly dispossessing him from the temple.

Learned counsel further submits that vide order dated 26.11.2020, the civil Court has directed the respondents not to interfere in the possession of the petitioner in an illegal manner, except in due course of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that since the private respondents are pressurizing the petitioner and trying to take the possession of the temple forcibly, the petitioner has filed an application under Order 39 Rule 2A of the CPC for compliance of the aforesaid order.

In view of the above, this petition is not maintainable as the petitioner can approach the civil Court concerned seeking police protection for the compliance of order dated 26.11.2020.

Dismissed.
