The petitioner raises objection to 5 questions for the Preliminary Examination of Punjab Civil Services which was held on 13.02.2021. It is his case that as per his assessment, he had secured 245 marks and the cut off marks which has now been given for the General Category is 244.5. It is, thus, his grouse that he has not been called for written examination which has to take place on 01.04.2021. It is further averred that regarding five questions as such, the fate of the objection is not known and, therefore, benefit should be given .

Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-Commission as he has been supplied the copy of the paper book in advance. He submits that he has instructions to say that

the petitioner has only secured 135 marks and, therefore, is nowhere close to the cut off zone. He further submitted that the said marks have been put in public domain and are on the website of the Commission.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present writ petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed.
