Through this criminal writ petition, the petitioner is praying for a writ of mandamus by way of directions to the respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect his life and liberty from private respondent Nos.4 to 6 and further for registering FIR under Section 379-B IPC and Arms Act, 1959 against private respondents.

Concededly, the allegations by the petitioner are against his own daughter-in-law, with whom the relations of his son are cordial. Further, a perusal of the complaint dated 06.12.2019 (Annexure P-3) reveals that the weapon belonging to the petitioner was allegedly taken away by his daughter-in-law and the grievance of the petitioner that no action has been taken upon his complaint (Annexure P-6) can be raised by him by adopting an alternative remedy.

Resultantly, no case is made out for exercising the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
