1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Order violation of which has been complained of is of 07.05.2014 whereas the instant petition has been filed in the year 2021. Section 20 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 contains a bar to the taking of action after the expiry of period of one year from the date of alleged violation. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to avail alternative proceedings in accordance with law.

3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no case is made out for initiating proceedings against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 with the liberty as prayed for.
